More Recent Community News

In February 2015, The ECIA Board contracted with Home Owners Association Management Company (HOAMCO) to provide the ECIA with a general manager (GM) and accounting services. In April 2016 all employees became direct employees of HOAMCO. Several GMs served for short lengths of time. Brenda Leonard started as an interim GM in September 2015 and in December 2015 became ECIA's full time GM.

On March 28, 2016, the New Mexico Court of Appeals issued a ruling in the hens as pets suit, ECIA v. Billings et.al. In a unanimous decision, the appellate court found that the ECIA covenants do not prevent the keeping of hens as pets in the development. The ECIA Board decided not to take further legal action.

On March 1, 2016 the NM Court of Appeals has ruled in favor of the ECIA in the solar litigation suit contesting ground-based solar. In its unanimous decision, the three-judge panel granted summary judgment that the ECIA covenants do not prohibit the installation of ground-based solar arrays. The ruling, written by Judge M. Monica Zamora, states that the NM "Legislature declared void any covenant that effectively prohibited the use of a solar collector." The Court also dismissed various objections that the appellant had raised during court proceedings. The ruling affirms the summary judgment in favor of the ECIA issued by Judge Francis J. Matthew at the district Court level.
