This structure is built of straw and mud with a metal flat room. In the past it was used as a play house. The structure rests on the ground and is not portable. Current structure is in bad condition and owner has agreed to stucco the slanting sides and side walls the color tumbleweed. The Architecture Committee is willing to allow the structure based on the stucco agreement.

Current architecture guidelines specify:

Limitations and Requirements:

1. Shall be sited within fifteen (15) feet of the dwelling house.
