April 26, 2021 President's Report

Change in COVID 19 status

- Santa Fe County is now Turquoise
- Allows groups of up to 150 people
- Dog park, tennis, pickleball, basketball courts and playgrounds open
- Masks and social distancing required

Annual Report Distribution

- A 2020 Annual Report was mailed to every resident in Eldorado, a total of 2776 copies.
- Residents whose 2021 Assessment was cleared and posted to their account by March 1 and therefore considered a Member in Good Standing, also received a ballot and quorum proxy. This accounted for 2319 lot owners an increase of 5% of lot owners over last year's mailing.
- This year there was a purposeful recommended due date of February 15th so that checks and credit payments could clear in a timely fashion.
- Perhaps the ability to pay assessments on-site and encouraging an earlier payment due date supported more voter eligibility.
- And a reminder, if a resident owns more than one lot, they received a report and voting materials [assuming they are MIGS] for each lot; example: if a resident owns 3 lots, they would receive 3 reports and 3 ballots/quorum proxies.
