# ECIA Board of Directors Meeting March 22, 2021 President's Report

### Change in COVID 19 status

- Santa Fe County is now green
- Allows groups of up to 20 people
- Dog park, tennis, pickleball, basketball courts and playgrounds open
- Masks and social distancing required

#### **Community Center**

- As of Monday, April 5, the Community Center is open
- Doors will be unlocked, restrooms available for members
- Staff will monitor the number of people in the building
- Still recommend that residents make appointments with staff to ensure access
- ECIA Committees have option to meet in-person at Community Center, continue to ZOOM meetings or hybrid – in-person and ZOOM
- Other groups such as OA, Yoga, Bible Study, parties, etc. are not yet allowed to use the Community Center for gatherings
- Beginning today, there are 2 large boxes outside the front door: one box is for Assessment Payments only and one box for Election Ballots. Please remember that if you place your Assessment in the Election box, it will not be opened until April 29.

## Earth Day Celebration

- Santa Fe County sponsored event will take place Saturday, May 15 from 9 AM to 5 PM at the Max Coll Community Center
- County hopes that individuals and/groups will adopt or dedicate one or more of the drought tolerant pollinator plantings
- County will provide signage for the plant as long as the group or individual maintain it [watering, etc.]
- COVID 19 restrictions will apply: masks are required and social distancing will be maintained by scheduling volunteers in 1 ½ hours sessions.
- Participants should bring a hat, work gloves and water bottle; restrooms will be available.
- Please look for more details about this event in the May VISTAS and on eblasts and marquees.
