- Review of April, 2021, Income and Bank Statements
- Review of Accounts Receivable and Collection Activities—Julie reported that she has contacted all accounts newly behind for 2021, and only 21new liens have been issued for 2020 vs. about 80 for 2020. Accounts Receivable balance of money owed to ECIA is down over \$50K from April 2020.
- Reserve Cash transfer--\$50K recommended by FC in April from Operations to smooth Reserve cash flow was done, but too late to show on April financial report.

- Baby pool replastering scheduled—good time since Baby pool not opening.
- Outdoor Shower—rinse only—installed, including hot water. Changing room also expected to be open.
- Playground and Dog Park mulch being replaced/replaced.
- A new Pool handicapped space has been designated for improved access.
- Picnic table frames are good, only need new wood at cost savings.
- Smart locks and gate latches proposed for Dog Park to limit access/liability from non-ECIA users.
- Transfer of ECIA property near stables to EAWSD—Quitclaim deed prepared, but needs precise Boundary Survey to match existing fence—have it done professionally if necessary. Deed from AMREP to ECIA for stable property appears to anticipate property used by EAWSD being transferred.
- Security Camera Installations—Compadres Park signals now received at Community Center, needs tweaking.

- Pool electricity use—gas space heaters being investigated for winter changing room and mechanical room freeze prevention for greater efficiency.
