# OM Updates – Kathy Ritschel

• Concrete pathways have been completed to the courts.

- Pool landscaping is complete and looks great.
- Compadres basketball court will be resurfaced the week of June 28. Skateboarders and Roller Bladers are welcome to use this surface.
- Picnic tables are being redone.
- RFPs have been sent out to vendors for the Proximity Card Readers at the courts and the pool. Two proposals have been submitted.
- The County has begun planning phase for the Azul and Torreon hike/bike trails.

### **AGM Updates – Jessica Collins**

- First, many kudos to Kevin for successfully executing all the hands-on pool operations. First opening weekend was a hit, a little slower than we thought, probably due to the holiday weekend.
- The lifeguards had their skills already put to the test. Though we have lifeguards on-duty, we encourage all parents and caretakers to keep a close eye on their little ones show them where the pool starts to get deeper and a line not to cross.
- The kiddie pool plaster project is complete, and the chemicals are stable waiting for the opportunity for inspection and opening. Until then, we would like to purchase a new platform for smaller children. After inspection of the old platform, there are some potential hazards.
- Residents should be on the lookout in the upcoming days for an eBlast to sign up for pool closure updates as well as to sign up for swim lessons.
- Main pool mechanical room is running, working toward balancing pool chemicals, and heating the pool.
- Spoke with pool inspector last week, wading pool cannot be open during current order. Inspection on Tuesday, May 11<sup>th.</sup>
- Pool passes now available at Community Center office—residents will sign 2021 waiver to include acknowledgement of receipt and understanding of pool rules.
- Swim lessons still in planning stages. Organized group lessons will be during the day on weekdays, private lessons available on evenings and weekends.

- All Committee Chairs have been asked to submit 2022 Capital Projects request this week.

  - o 2022: Compadres Park upgrades: Install shade structure like the pool structures to prevent over exposure from the sun. Xeriscape area around playground.
